



## 2nd HABAWABA Brasil Festival

### GENERAL REGULATIONS

Brazil, 2021

The Associação Bauruense De Desportes Aquáticos ("ABDA"), authorized by *Water Polo Development Association*, based in Lignano Sabbiadoro, Italy, to hold the 2nd HaBaWaBa Festival in Brazil, makes public the **GENERAL REGULATIONS** that will govern the event, approved by its Executive Board.

#### CLAUSE I - THE FESTIVAL

1.1 - The 2nd Festival Habawaba Brasil 2021 will be held from 08 to 12 December 2021, in the "ARENA ABDA", located at Rua Fábio Geraldo, Nº 2-12, Jardim Solange, in the city of Bauru, State of São Paulo, from 08: 00 (local).

#### CLAUSE II – THE FESTIVAL CATEGORIES

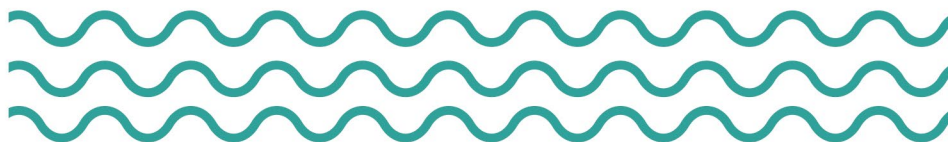
2.1 - The Festival will contemplate mixed teams, formed by athletes (boys and girls) with a maximum of 13 (thirteen) years.

#### CLAUSE III - REGISTRATION

3.1 - Teams formed by athletes who are formally linked to it in their centers of origin, as well as who are in a totally regular situation before the water sports management entities of their nationality may register and take part in the 2nd HaBaWaBa Brazil Festival. Registrations will be received from August 26, 2021 until October 30, 2021, and on November 1, 2021 the number of teams registered will be disclosed and on December 1, 2021 the games schedule of the Festival will be disclosed.

**Sole paragraph** -Entries will be accepted from National, South American teams and also teams invited and approved by the organization of the event.





**3.2** – The teams interested in registering for the Festival will have to fill in the **APPLICATION FORM (ATHLETE / TEAM)**, made available on the website of the organization of the event, agreeing to all the terms and conditions set forth therein.

**3.3** - The teams registered in the Festival must confirm their participation in the Festival, formally and in an imperative way until October 30, 2021, by sending an e-mail to: [contato@habawababrasil.com.br](mailto:contato@habawababrasil.com.br)

**3.4** – The team that does not confirm its participation by the date indicated in clause 3.3 will not be able to take part in the Festival.

**3.5** – The teams will be mixed, with the participation of athletes of both sexes, being composed of a maximum of 13 (thirteen) athletes and a minimum of 7 (seven) athletes, born from the year 2008, aged between 9 (nine) years and 13 (thirteen) years.

**3.6** – Registrations will incur in the following fees: (a) US 100.00 (one hundred dollars) per team + (b) US 5.00 (five dollars) per person in the team to be paid, by bank transfer, in the following account: Banco Bradesco (237), Agency: 2289-6; current account: 19.969-9; holder: Associação Bauruense De Desportes Aquáticos; CNPJ nº 13.282.547/0001-79.

**3.7** - All teams must also indicate who are the people, within each Technical Committee, who will present themselves as those legally responsible for the minor athletes, keeping them under their constant supervision and care.

**3.8** - Teams, athletes, technical committees and those responsible for minors must make available to the Organizing Committee of the Festival, together with their registration forms, 01 (a) 3cmx4cm photograph of each member of the delegation, copy of their passports, with valid expiration date, copy of the personal identification document. **3.9** - It will not be allowed to replace athletes, members of the technical committee, as well as and much less those responsible for the athletes after confirmation of the registrations.

**3.10** - Athletes will not be allowed to take part in more than 01 (one) team for which they have been registered.





**3.11** - Registration at the Festival will guarantee to each athlete the delivery of a Kit, being composed of: 01 (one) personalized badge; festival T-shirt; bag; cap; bath towel; brochure; Athlete Passport and tattoo with theme related to the Festival. The Kit will be delivered to the athletes on December 8, 2021, at the ABDA ARENA, in the time between 12: 00 to 20: 00.

**3.12** - It will be the responsibility of each registered Team (Athlete, Team, Technical Committee and responsible) the transit between the airport, in Brazil, and its place of accommodation.

**3.13** - All athletes must have the proper and necessary permits for international travel, issued by their countries of origin, as well as those required by the Brazilian government, through the Ministry of Justice and the Federal Police.

**3.14** - All athletes must have insurance.

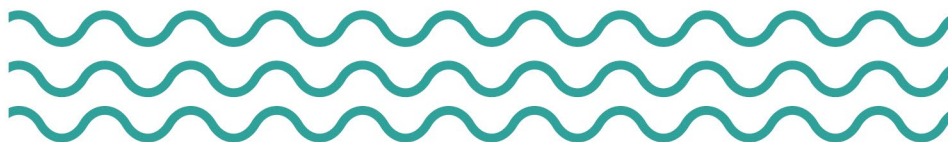
#### **CLAUSE IV - HOSTING OF ATTENDING TEAMS**

**4.1** – The Organizing Committee offers as a suggestion of accommodation the Emburi hotels (Piratinga-SP) and Intercity (Bauru-SP) that will provide promotional prices to the attendees of the event.

**4.2** - All consumption that is carried out by the teams, by their athletes, by the technical committees and by their representatives, in their respective rooms, must be paid by them, at the time when the accommodation is closed, directly with the hotel.

**4.3** - Athletes, teams, technical committees and responsible adults, may also, during the period of realization of the Festival, enjoy, recreationally, through "day-use", the facilities offered by The" Novo Thermas – Piratinga", consisting of a water park located in the same locality of "Hotel Emburi". The trip to "Novo Thermas-Piratinga" should be held at the free time after and/or before the team's games and previously scheduled with the organizing committee of the event.





**4.4** - The athletes, teams, technical committee and those responsible who accompany them must observe, in an unrestricted way, the regulations of “Novo Thermas – Piratininga”, made available when the registration is formalized, also being fully responsible for any and all damage that the disrespectful use may cause to “Novo Thermas-Piratininga”.

## **CLAUSE V - THE OPENING AND CLOSING CEREMONIES**

**5.1** – The teams must take part in the opening and closing ceremonies of the Festival, in accordance with the rules made by the organization of the events, wearing the festival uniform or the uniforms representative of their nationalities/associations/teams, and must observe, with precision, the schedules that will be made available by the Organizing Committee.

## **CLAUSE VI – PLAYING THE MATCHES**

**6.1** – Each team must, in its first game, with 30 (thirty) minutes before the start of the match, present to the arbitration table, the nominal relation of the athletes, containing the name and the respective numbering of their cap, as well as the relation of the members of the technical committee.

**Sole paragraph** - After delivering the list of athletes to the arbitration table, no change in its composition will be possible.

**6.2** - Entry into the places of realization of the matches (in the pools) will only be allowed to the teams that will play, as well as to persons duly authorized and identified by means of badge that will be made and provided by the Organization of the Festival.

**6.3** - Matches will be played in tournament format. The games schedule will be composed by drawing amongst the registered teams that will take place on December 1, 2021.

**First paragraph** - The total number of games per team will be conditioned on the total number of teams registered.

**Second paragraph** - All teams will enter the open draw in the composition of the brackets.





**6.4** – All the equipment to carry out the matches will be provided by the Organizing Committee of the Festival, observing the standards adopted by “*Water Polo Development Association*”.

**6.5** - The matches will take place according to the rules established and approved by the Organization of the Festival, appearing in the “primer” that will be delivered to the technicians of each registered team, as well made available on the website of the event.

## **CLAUSE VII - ARBITRATION**

**7.1** – The arbitration of the matches, throughout the Festival, will be carried out by volunteers, and those interested in participating should follow the procedures that will be made available on the event's website.

**7.2** – Deadline for registration of volunteers- 08/15/2021.

## **CLAUSE VIII - RULES AND FORMAT OF THE COMPETITION**

**8.1** – The Festival will take place with the adapted rules of the HaBaWaBa Festival, organized by “*Water Polo Development Association*”.

**8.2** - The rules will consist of a primer that will accompany this regulation and that will be made available to the teams at the time of registration.

**8.3** – The format of the competition will be as follows: - from 15 to 20 teams Form 5 groups with 3 or 4 teams per group. In Phase 1 everyone faces each other. In Phase 2, the teams are divided into two series, where in each series, everyone faces each other. Titan is composed of the top 3 positions in each group, Tsu is composed of the last placed of each group. The full information of the tournament format is available on the website and in the coach's booklet.

## **CLAUSE IX – PENALTIES**

**9.1** – During the days of the event, conduct that is contrary to morality, good manners and ethics will not be tolerated, and athletes, technical committees and companions should always behave with the utmost decorum and respect.





**Sole paragraph** - Any conduct contrary to the provisions of the *caption* from this clause, upon reaching the knowledge of the Organizing Committee of the event, will be submitted to a judging committee, formed by professionals linked to the National Organization of the Festival, which will analyze the conduct and apply the penalties, according to the severity of the act, and may be (I) mere warning; (II) prohibition to take part in the games; (III) expulsion from the Festival.

## **CLAUSE X – IMAGE RIGHTS**

**10.1** – Each member of the teams enrolled in the Festival, at the time of their registration, will declare that they are the sole holders of all patrimonial and extra-patrimonial rights relating to their images, assigning them to be of use of the festival Habawaba Brasil 2021, without any cost or payment.

**Sole paragraph** - The provided images will be represented by photographic and audiovisual records, for reproduction in physical, printed and digital media.

**10.2** - The provided images will be used in the promotion of the event, in advertising pieces related to the event, in banners to be used to promote the event and everything else related to the Festival, being broadcast in the following media: magazines, newspapers, printed, banners, billboards, flyers, internet, radio, television or in similar means of dissemination.

**First paragraph** The provided images may be used on the following media channels: Instagram, Facebook, Twitter, YouTube, radio, television and radio channels.

**Second paragraph** - The provided images will be used within the geographical limit that delimits the Brazilian national territory.

**Third paragraph** - The rights granted may only be used in the ways defined by this regulation, and the Festival organization may not sell or grant these rights to third parties.

**Fourth paragraph** - The provided images will be for the exclusive use of the Festival organization, who will have the right to take judicial and/or extrajudicial measures to prevent the use of the image by third parties.

**10.3** - The Organization of the Festival is not responsible for the improper use of the images transferred and that are captured by third parties in exhibitions and/or reproductions occurred in accordance with the specifications provided in this regulation.
